1) There were no declarations of interest for the meeting.

## 2) Public Open Session:

Several parishioners spoke of their strong concerns over the Certificate of lawfulness planning application at Fords Yard, Menmarsh Road as they live nearby and that they believed the site has not been residential for any long period in that there was no water supply or sewage system and believed council tax had not been paid. They understood that someone stayed fairly frequent in the mobile caravan that was used as an office.

## 3) Planning Applications:

<u>P15/S0885/LDE</u> – Fords Yard Menmarsh Road Worminghall HP18 9UP – Certificate of lawfulness for existing use for the land to be residential.

Waterperry Parish Council heard strong objections as to whether the land has been used as residential for a long period of time and will refer to these in its response to SODC which Sue agreed to write up and get agreed with the other councillors attending.
