3) Open Discussions and Questions from parishioners:

There were three items on the meeting agenda that were discussed:

WATERPERRY HOUSE AND GARDENS LARGE EVENTS NEW VILLAGE SIGN AND SPEED LIMIT SIGNS RECREATION GROUND SEATING

Simon Buchannan, bursar of Waterperry House and Gardens had invited the organiser of Celebrating Ceramics to the meeting and both discussed the two larger events taking place this summer in the grounds of Waterperry House along with what they were doing to try to mitigate traffic issues. A long discussion took place between the councillors and parishioners attending and Simon and the organiser of Celebrating Ceramics. Complimentary tickets for Handmade Oxford at the end of June will be delivered to villagers with the June parish magazine.

Sue discussed the latest progress of the 20mph within Waterperry Village which includes removal of some existing signage, new gates, new signage and a VAS unit which will be placed just before the first house as one enters the village. Sue to progress funding of approximately £5k and progressing with OCC.
